

## Dräger Fireman's Gloves

### LAUNDERING, STORAGE & DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS

(FOR WATER REPELLANT LEATHER)



Wash with mild soap and cool water. Harsh detergents and extremely hot water will cause the protective oils and chemicals in the leather to dissipate, thus affecting its properties.

DO NOT USE BLEACH. Bleach or other chlorinated substances will weaken the KEVLAR and is also likely to compromise the oils and chemicals in the leather.

Rinse thoroughly and gently wring dry. Hang to air dry only. DO NOT hang in sunlight as the as the ultraviolet rays could cause changes in the characteristics/properties of KEVLAR.

DO NOT force dry with hair dryer, place over a heating duct or expose to extreme temperatures. Such forced drying will lead to hardening/stiffening of the gloves.

DO NOT, at any time, use gloves that have not been cleaned and dried. This could jeopardize your safety by irritating and/or infecting the skin.

### STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

Store the gloves in cool and dry place away from direct sunlight. Keep away from sources of ozone or ultra-violet radiation. DO NOT stuff wet leather gloves in turnout pockets between calls.

### DISPOSAL

In the event decontamination of the gloves is not possible (i.e. chemical, radiological or biological) after use, dispose in accordance with local Authority Regulations.
